- IV. Obligations of G.I.Bagewdi College and Rayanna Goat and Sheep farm rearing and training centre :**
- Department will provide necessary and appropriate guidance, supervision and support for the improvement of students and staff of both the parties
 - Department will allow the necessary scientific required for animal husbandry from college
- And also vice versa further both shall put in place adequate and reasonable measures to keep and store confidential secure so as to prevent unauthorized use

General Article.

This Mou Shall be binding on the both the parties as long as there exists spirit of co-operation. Nothing in the MoU, expresses or implied, is intended to or shall confer upon any person other than the contracting parties here to any right, benefit or remedy of any other nature whatsoever under or by reason of this MoU.

Confidentiality:

During the tenure of MoU both the departments will maintain strict Confidentiality and prevent disclosure of all the information and data exchange under the scope of this MoU for any purpose other than in accordance with MoU.

Both departments of G.I.Bagewdi College and Rayanna Goat and Sheep farm rearing and training centre shall bind their respective personnel who come into possession or knowledge of any confidential information not to disclose the same to third party without written approval of disclosing party or use such confidential information for any other than intended under this agreement or project program.

Further both, department G.I.Bagewdi College and Rayanna Goat and Sheep farm rearing and training centre shall put in place adequate and reasonable measures to keep and store confidential secure so as to prevent any unauthorized use.

Confidential information: Shall mean any proprietary information, data or fact belonging to the parties collectively all severally, disclosed by the disclosing party under this agreement or any subsequent agreement, whether in writing verbal or electronically, irrespective of the medium in which such information is told, which is marked confidential or with any other word having similar meaning by the disclosing party or specially agreed to be kept confidential by the parties or the discussion. - b) Is already in the original possession of receiving party prior to its receipt of such information
- c) Which is independently developed by receiving party without reference to the confidential information of the disclosing party
- d) Is rightly obtained by the receiving party, from the third or is the public domain
- e) Is disclosed with written consent of the party whose information it is
- f) Is disclosed pursuant to court order or legal compulsion, after providing prior notice to the disclosing party

Amendments:

Any amendment and/or agenda to the agreement shall be in written in and signed by PARTIES here to and shall only after such execution be deemed to form part of the Agreement and have effect of modifying the to the extent required by such amendment or addenda.

Resolution of Disputes

- a) This agreement shall take effect and construed in accordance with the laws of and the subject of jurisdiction of the court at Nipani
- b) The dispute or difference whatever arises between PARTIES in relation to or in connection with this AGREEMENT both the parties shall first try to resolve dispute/differences amicably between themselves

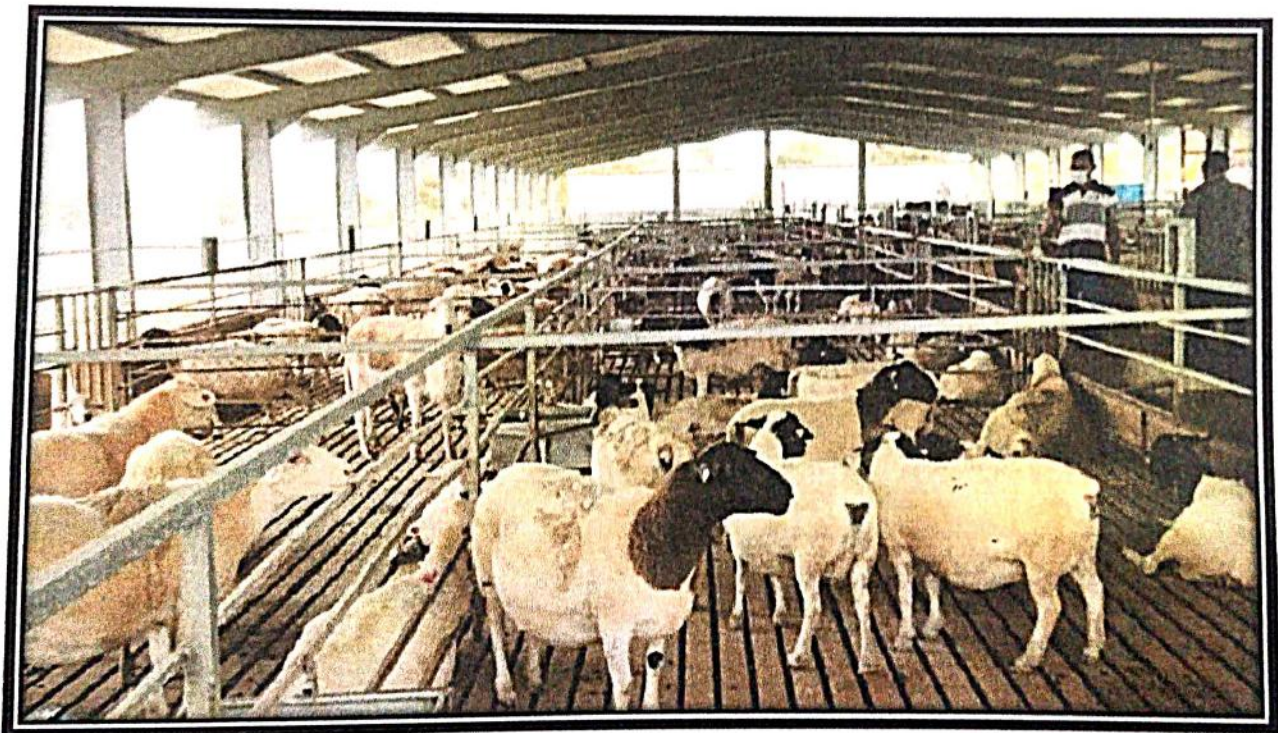
INTRODUCTION

The main moto of our Field visit was to gain knowledge about breeding techniques used in sheep.or cattle breeding centre.

The staff members of Zoology department planned to visit the sheep and cattle breeding centre at Kallolli (Gokak).

On 17th June 2023, we started our journey from Nipani to Kallolli. We caught 10am bus from Nipani reached Kallolli at 12pm. In Kallolli we visited Mr. Maruti Maradi's sheep breeding centre and learnt which type of breeding techniques they are using, how they are maintaining the breeding centre according to season wise.

Then we all came back to Nipani and it was most useful and memorable for us.



Electrical works, pipelines, plumbing and sanitary works:

Power supply is required for both shed and domestic lighting purposes. The promoter has to make arrangements for providing adequate power supply and electrification work along with lighting arrangements. It is also required to provide pipelines and water supply system for shed and buildings along with undertaking plumbing and sanitary works. The total cost provision made for these items is Rs. 75000/- on lump sum basis.

HOUSING AND CIVIL WORK:

Construction of sheep shed:

The main civil work include construction of shed for parent breeding stock in an area 5500 Sft with 5 ft height raised platform with compartments along with kid shed and sick pen in an area of 3500 sft for new born young ones and lambs as well as sick animals. The compartments are fitted with feeding trays and safety gates and flooring is done with plastic/wooden rafts. The shed will be constructed on raised platform with concrete block AC sheets roofing on iron trusses with cross ventilation. The total cost provision made for construction of sheep shed is Rs. 29.00 lakhs at unit cost of Rs. 400/Sft. and 200/SSft.respectively.

Other utility structures proposed are fodder chopping and storage area, one feed storage room for feed concentrates and mineral mixtures, silage pits for ensiling fodder for feeding animals which is delicious and nutritious and 2 labourquarters for residence purpose of labours. The total civil work and the cost are mentioned below.

The total estimated cost for civil work is Rs. 35.75 lakhs.

Inbreeding depression

Inbreeding depression refers to decrease or loss of fitness and strength which is mainly caused due to inbreeding. In simpler way the mating between relatives in a small population is common and this may lower the population ability to persist and reproduce which is referred to as inbreeding depression.

Inbreeding depression may varies across mating system. When male and female are crossed the young ones are formed, which is F1 generation. Also when F1 is crossed with male parent the young ones are formed. These are referred as F2 generation which have characters of less meat production, decrease in milk yield, carrier genetic disease and stunted growth.

Ex 1:-

When Nari suvarna of male and female crossed. The F1 generation has more and more meat production and has highest muscular growth, if we cross these F1 with male parent, F2 are produced.

In F2 generation we will find verities of characters like

- 1) The reduction of growth
- 2) Less weight

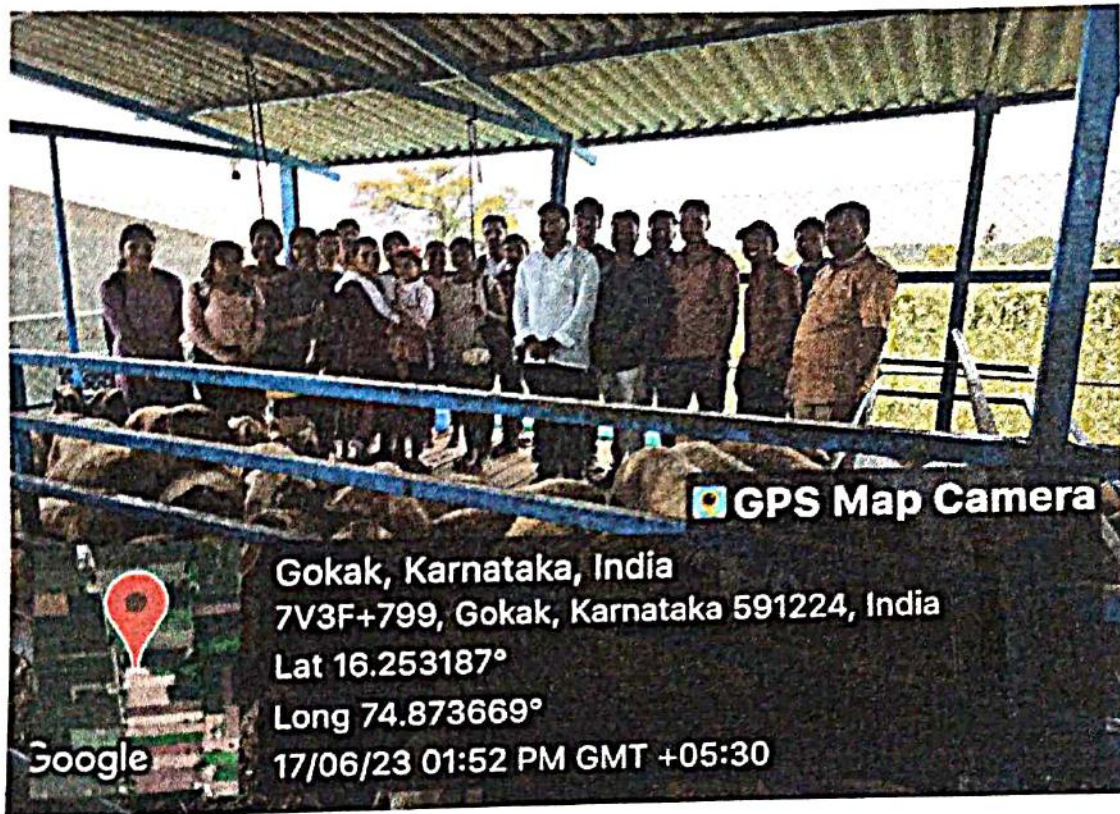
Ex 2:-

Deccan breed it can lead to reduce genetic diversity increasing the risk of harmful resessive traits becoming more tolerent. This can result in decreased fitness and health including reduced reproductive success and increased vulnerability disease.

Ex 3:-

Bittle has more meat production initially when young one is crossed with its male parent. The second generation have profusely decreases in meat production.

The above said inbreeding depression is carried in sheep and goat rearing centre Kalloli.



UBER COLLEGE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ('MOU') is made at Hubli, Karnataka, India on this 12th day of November 2020 by and between:

Deshpande Educational Trust, a charitable trust incorporated under the Indian Trusts Act 1882, and having its principal office at Airport Road, Hubballi, Karnataka 580030 India, (hereinafter "Deshpande Skilling") duly represented by its Chief Operating Officer, Mr. P.N. Navak which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the meaning or context thereof be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns

AND

"KLE Society's G I Bagewadi Arts, Science And Commerce College, Nipani" having its presence in District Belagum, Pin code - 591237 offering technical diploma / under graduation courses for B.Com, BA, B.Sc., B.Ed., BBA, Diploma represented by its Prof. Shankarmurthy KN (hereinafter referred to as "Partner College", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the meaning or context thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and permitted assigns)

AND

DESHPANDE SKILLING and The PARTNER COLLEGE are hereinafter collectively referred to as 'Parties' and individually as a 'Party'.

WHEREAS:

1. DESHPANDE SKILLING a "not for profit" trust, an impact unit of Deshpande Foundation, India, and a training partner of National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), involved in the activity of conducting residential employability skills training programs for graduates of rural and semi urban colleges at its skilling campus in Hubballi, and providing placement assistance to its students. Deshpande Skilling is desirous to bring about rural transformation by building employability skills among graduate youth from rural and semi urban colleges and assist them earn their first employment in the formal sector. Deshpande Skilling wishes to admit job seeking students who pass out of college, but have failed to acquire the required skills to earn employment to its skilling program.
2. DESHPANDE SKILLING collects a fee from the students enrolling for the residential skilling program with the objective of ensuring ownership of the student in the exercise. The quantum of fees forms only part of the cost of the activity.

DESHPANDE SKILLING neither earns nor is desirous of any profit from the activity of skilling.

3. The **PARTNER COLLEGE** is desirous to see more of its students succeed to earn their employment in reputed organizations and also enhance its own placement record.
4. The two parties, **DESHPANDE SKILLING** and The **PARTNER COLLEGE** seek to partner with each other, to achieve the common goal of skilling graduate pass outs, and thereby succeed in starting their working career.
5. The principal and staff of the **PARTNER COLLEGE** will identify and recommend to **DESHPANDE SKILLING** names of final year students of the college who and inclined to join a job after graduating but are lacking in skills critical to earn their placement.
6. The principal and staff of the **PARTNER COLLEGE** will also identify deserving students who are financially challenged for concession in fees, and recommend same to **DESHPANDE SKILLING**.
7. **DESHPANDE SKILLING** will select students from the list recommended by the **PARTNER COLLEGE** and offers to admit, train and provide placement assistance to students who join the various programs.
8. **DESHPANDE SKILLING** offers skill training and placement assistance to students of many colleges and will form training cohorts of students from multiple colleges. Students of the **PARTNER COLLEGE** will be provided with common facilities and training services as all other students in training.
9. **DESHPANDE FOUNDATION** will offer concessional fee structure to the financially challenged students as per recommendation of the **PARTNER COLLEGE** principal. The total concession amount available to the students of the **PARTNER COLLEGE** will depend on the number of admissions, and will be mutually decided by the two parties.
10. The Parties recognize the capabilities and resources that each party brings, and agrees to use their best efforts to bring together those capabilities and resources to collaborate for the purpose of supporting skill-based training with **DESHPANDE SKILLING**. The **PARTNER COLLEGE** will support by identifying and counselling job seeking students to take benefit best from the skilling program. **DESHPANDE FOUNDATION** will support by skilling and placing students of the **PARTNER COLLEGE** and enhance its placement rate.

11. DESHPANDE SKILLING will work with the PARTNER COLLEGE to build a mindset of preparing early to earn a placement and start career among select students of the partner college. The 2 parties will agree on an annual activity calendar that could include group counselling and Q&A session, interaction with Alumni of the college who have been successful, remote classes for students, and any other activities that could give students awareness and exposure.

12. DESHPANDE FOUNDATION will also extend invitation to staff of the PARTNER COLLEGE to attend trainings and workshops that it will conduct on Skills Development for employability and other such areas that can contribute to enhancing placement record of the PARTNER COLLEGE.

The Parties are therefore entering into this **MOU** to record the terms and conditions of this collaboration. **DESHPANDE SKILLING** and **THE PARTNER COLLEGE** have agreed to enter into this MOU to record their present state of agreement in principle in respect of the **UBER College Partnership Program**.

NOW IT IS HEREBY MUTUALLY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

This collaboration between DESHPANDE SKILLING and THE PARTNER COLLEGE will be to impart skill training and provide placement assistance to select students of "THE PARTNER COLLEGE" to be able earn their first employment. The objective of this partnership is to facilitate rural transformation by getting rural youth into productive employment, and to enhance the placement record of the partner college.

Roles & Responsibilities of PARTNER COLLEGE:

1. Party would enter in MOU for the DESHPANDE SKILLING's "**UBER College Partnership Program**" for Skill development Training for interested students of The PARTNER COLLEGE.
2. PARTNER COLLEGE will support the program by recommending about 30 most suitable students of the college each year for the residential skilling program for graduate students conducted by DESHPANDE SKILLING at its Skilling campus.
3. PARTNER COLLEGE will recommend students from BA / B.Com/B.Sc. / BBA / BCA / B.Ed. /Technical Diploma / ITI streams only.
4. PARTNER COLLEGE will apply adequate justification for recommendation of each student for admission. The recommendation will be an informed decision that the student would benefit from the skilling program and the student and his/her family has a high "need for job".

5. PARTNER COLLEGE will avoid recommending candidates who already possess good employability skills, or candidates who are extremely low on employability skills or candidates who are not keen to start their working career immediately.
6. PARTNER COLLEGE will permit and facilitate representatives of DESHPANDE FOUNDATION to interact with the recommended students and their parents at the college for counselling before admission to the program.
7. The PARTNER COLLEGE will not have objection to DESHPANDE SKILLING collecting a part of the cost of skilling each student, in the form of fellowship fees from the students.
8. The PARTNER COLLEGE will identify and recommend reduction fellowship fees for selected candidates from the list of recommended candidates based on family of the specific candidate. The maximum recommendation for reduction in fellowship fees for any candidate will not exceed 50 % pf the fees. The cumulative discount amount recommended by the Partner colleges for the year will not exceed the limit mutually agreed between DESHPANDE SKILLING and the PARTNER COLLEGE.
9. The PARTNER COLLEGE will permit DESHPANDE SKILLING to list the PARTNER COLLEGE as its partner on its Web Site and other communication channels.

Roles & Responsibilities of DESHPANDE SKILLING:

1. DESHPANDE SKILLING will enter into MOU with the PARTNER COLLEGE and work closely with the college to develop student mindset for “preparing for placement” early and to enhance placement record of the Partner College by skilling select students at its residential skilling center and provide them placement assistance to earn their job offer.
2. DESHPANDE SKILLING will develop a calendar of interactions with select students of the partner college to develop awareness of job roles, competencies for job roles and a mindset for preparing for job roles right from their first year in college.
3. DESHPANDE SKILLING will counsel students recommended by the college and assess their trainability and need for job before admitting the students for the residential skilling program.

4. DESHPANDE SKILLING will provide the skill training to students of the partner college at its residential skilling facility as per academic plan of the specific program into which they are admitted.
5. DESHPANDE SKILLING will offer placement assistance to students of the Partner College admitted to its skilling program. Every student will be provided with multiple opportunities for placement process of different companies.
6. DESHPANDE SKILLING will with employer organizations to understand current and future skill requirements of employers and also to invite employers to provide opportunity to fellows of the skilling program for openings in their organizations.
7. THE PARTNER COLLEGE will be branded in DESHPANDE SKILLING's program website and other relevant platforms which are viewed by community of employers.
8. DESHPANDE SKILLING will provide updates about the progress of students of the partner college to the placement officer and principal of the partner college. The partner college will also be updated about the job offers received by its students.
9. DESHPANDE SKILLING retains its right to charge the students skill trainings.
10. DESHPANDE SKILLING will communicate that the partner college can extend to its financially challenged students during the first week of January each year.
11. DESHPANDE SKILLING will provide training completion certificates to all such students who have successfully completed the training. The certificate will bear the logo of NSDC and DESHPANDE SKILLING.
12. DESHPANDE SKILLING will provide placement assistance to students of the program thru its in-house Placement Assistance Cell or its placement partners.



Deshpande Educational Trust, a charitable trust incorporated under the Indian Trusts Act 1882, and having its principal office at Airport Road, Hubballi, Karnataka 580030 India, (hereinafter "Deshpande Skilling") duly represented by its Chief Operating Officer, Mr. P.N. Nayak which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the meaning or context thereof be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns

AND

"KLE Society's G I Bagewadi Arts, Science And Commerce College, Nipani" having its presence in District Belagum, Pin code - 591237 offering technical diploma / under graduation courses for B.Com, BA, B.Sc., B.Ed., BBA, Diploma represented by its Prof. Shankarmurthy KN (hereinafter referred to as "Partner College", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the meaning or context thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and permitted assigns)

AND

DESHPANDE SKILLING and The PARTNER COLLEGE are hereinafter collectively referred to as 'Parties' and individually as a 'Party'.

WHEREAS:

1. DESHPANDE SKILLING a "not for profit" trust, an impact unit of Deshpande Foundation, India, and a training partner of National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), involved in the activity of conducting residential employability skills training programs for graduates of rural and semi urban colleges at its skilling campus in Hubballi, and providing placement assistance to its students. Deshpande Skilling is desirous to bring about rural transformation by building employability skills among graduate youth from rural and semi urban colleges and assist them earn their first employment in the formal sector. Deshpande Skilling wishes to admit job seeking students who pass out of college, but have failed to acquire the required skills to earn employment to its skilling program.
2. DESHPANDE SKILLING collects a fee from the students enrolling for the residential skilling program with the objective of ensuring ownership of the student in the exercise. The quantum of fees forms only part of the cost of the activity.

DESHPANDE SKILLING neither earns nor is desirous of any profit from the activity of skilling.

3. The PARTNER COLLEGE is desirous to see more of its students succeed to earn their employment in reputed organizations and also enhance its own placement record.
4. The two parties, DESHPANDE SKILLING and The PARTNER COLLEGE seek to partner with each other, to achieve the common goal of skilling graduate pass outs, and thereby succeed in starting their working career.
5. The principal and staff of the PARTNER COLLEGE will identify and recommend to DESHPANDE SKILLING names of final year students of the college who are inclined to join a job after graduating but are lacking in skills critical to earn their placement.
6. The principal and staff of the PARTNER COLLEGE will also identify deserving students who are financially challenged for concession in fees, and recommend same to DESHPANDE SKILLING.
7. DESHPANDE SKILLING will select students from the list recommended by the PARTNER COLLEGE and offers to admit, train and provide placement assistance to students who join the various programs.
8. DESHPANDE SKILLING offers skill training and placement assistance to students of many colleges and will form training cohorts of students from multiple colleges. Students of the PARTNER COLLEGE will be provided with common facilities and training services as all other students in training.
9. DESHPANDE FOUNDATION will offer concessional fee structure to the financially challenged students as per recommendation of the PARTNER COLLEGE principal. The total concession amount available to the students of the PARTNER COLLEGE will depend on the number of admissions, and will be mutually decided by the two parties.
10. The Parties recognize the capabilities and resources that each party brings, and agrees to use their best efforts to bring together those capabilities and resources to collaborate for the purpose of supporting skill-based training with DESHPANDE SKILLING. The PARTNER COLLEGE will support by identifying and counselling job seeking students to take benefit best from the skilling program. DESHPANDE FOUNDATION will support by skilling and placing students of the PARTNER COLLEGE and enhance its placement rate.

11. DESHPANDE SKILLING will work with the PARTNER COLLEGE to build a mindset of preparing early to earn a placement and start career among select students of the partner college. The 2 parties will agree on an annual activity calendar that could include group counselling and Q&A session, interaction with Alumni of the college who have been successful, remote classes for students, and any other activities that could give students awareness and exposure.
12. DESHPANDE FOUNDATION will also extend invitation to staff of the PARTNER COLLEGE to attend trainings and workshops that it will conduct on Skills Development for employability and other such areas that can contribute to enhancing placement record of the PARTNER COLLEGE.

The Parties are therefore entering into this MOU to record the terms and conditions of this collaboration. **DESHPANDE SKILLING** and **THE PARTNER COLLEGE** have agreed to enter into this MOU to record their present state of agreement in principle in respect of the **UBER College Partnership Program**.

NOW IT IS HEREBY MUTUALLY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

This collaboration between DESHPANDE SKILLING and THE PARTNER COLLEGE will be to impart skill training and provide placement assistance to select students of "THE PARTNER COLLEGE" to be able earn their first employment. The objective of this partnership is to facilitate rural transformation by getting rural youth into productive employment, and to enhance the placement record of the partner college.

Roles & Responsibilities of PARTNER COLLEGE:

1. Party would enter in MOU for the DESHPANDE SKILLING's "**UBER College Partnership Program**" for Skill development Training for interested students of The PARTNER COLLEGE.
2. PARTNER COLLEGE will support the program by recommending about 30 most suitable students of the college each year for the residential skilling program for graduate students conducted by DESHPANDE SKILLING at its Skilling campus.
3. PARTNER COLLEGE will recommend students from BA / B.Com/B.Sc. / BBA / BCA / B.Ed. /Technical Diploma / ITI streams only.
4. PARTNER COLLEGE will apply adequate justification for recommendation of each student for admission. The recommendation will be an informed decision that the student would benefit from the skilling program and the student and his/her family has a high "need for job".

5. PARTNER COLLEGE will avoid recommending candidates who already possess good employability skills, or candidates who are extremely low on employability skills or candidates who are not keen to start their working career immediately.
6. PARTNER COLLEGE will permit and facilitate representatives of DESHPANDE FOUNDATION to interact with the recommended students and their parents at the college for counselling before admission to the program.
7. The PARTNER COLLEGE will not have objection to DESHPANDE SKILLING collecting a part of the cost of skilling each student, in the form of fellowship fees from the students.
8. The PARTNER COLLEGE will identify and recommend reduction fellowship fees for selected candidates from the list of recommended candidates based on family of the specific candidate. The maximum recommendation for reduction in fellowship fees for any candidate will not exceed 50 % of the fees. The cumulative discount amount recommended by the Partner colleges for the year will not exceed the limit mutually agreed between DESHPANDE SKILLING and the PARTNER COLLEGE.
9. The PARTNER COLLEGE will permit DESHPANDE SKILLING to list the PARTNER COLLEGE as its partner on its Web Site and other communication channels.

Roles & Responsibilities of DESHPANDE SKILLING:

1. DESHPANDE SKILLING will enter into MOU with the PARTNER COLLEGE and work closely with the college to develop student mindset for "preparing for placement" early and to enhance placement record of the Partner College by skilling select students at its residential skilling center and provide them placement assistance to earn their job offer.
2. DESHPANDE SKILLING will develop a calendar of interactions with select students of the partner college to develop awareness of job roles, competencies for job roles and a mindset for preparing for job roles right from their first year in college.
3. DESHPANDE SKILLING will counsel students recommended by the college and assess their trainability and need for job before admitting the students for the residential skilling program.





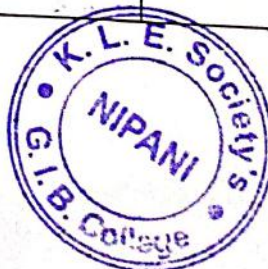

(Bajaj Finserv Limited and Bajaj Finance Limited hereinafter collectively referred to as "FINSERV" and shall be represented by its authorized representative Mr. Kurush Irani - President (Corporate Social Responsibility) Bajaj Finserv Limited)

The expressions "PARTNER INSTITUTE" and "FINSERV" shall, collectively be referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party".

WHEREAS:

- A. PARTNER INSTITUTE established in 1961 by KLE society is affiliated to Rani Channamma University, Belagavi.
- B. Bajaj Finserv Limited is the holding company for financial services businesses of the Bajaj Group;
- C. Bajaj Finance Limited is a Non-Banking Finance Company registered with Reserve Bank of India.
- D. FINSERV, as part of its Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activities, desires to create employment opportunities for educated youth in the Banking, Finance and Insurance Sector through a customized training Program/s encompassing product knowledge, communication and other soft skills, which is expected to benefit fresh

graduates, especially those belonging to economically weaker sections of the society;

- E. FINSERV, in partnership with some of the leading educational institutes, has designed and developed customized corporate certification program/s under its IN-HOUSE skilling Program called as SKILLSERV
- F. The PARTNER INSTITUTE has expressed its willingness to partner with FINSERV to conduct SKILLSERV Program/s for its students and alumni, on terms and conditions set out herein below;
- G. FINSERV has accepted the offer of the PARTNER INSTITUTE and agreed to partner with the PARTNER INSTITUTE for conducting SKILLSERV Program/s, on terms and conditions set out below.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AND IT IS AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS UNDER:

1. Purpose/Objective of SKILLSERV:

The objective of SKILLSERV is to impart practical knowledge and essential skills to the students of the PARTNER INSTITUTE, especially those belonging to economically weaker sections of the society, with a view to create employment opportunities for them in the Banking, Finance and Insurance Companies.

2. Scope of SKILLSERV:

- i. FINSERV has appointed different training institutes as Official Training Partners for conducting SKILLSERV Program/s (hereinafter referred to as SKILLSERV Official Training Partner/s).
- ii. FINSERV and the PARTNER INSTITUTE, through one of the SKILLSERV Official Training Partners, shall conduct, for the eligible students and alumni of the PARTNER INSTITUTE, Certificate Program/s in Banking, Finance and Insurance sector, covering industry overview/product knowledge relevant for various roles in banks, NBFCs, life insurance and general insurance companies, communication and other workplace skills. SKILLSERV Program/s shall be conducted through classroom training (hereinafter referred to as SKILLSERV -CLASSROOM), online training (hereinafter referred to as SKILLSERV -ONLINE) or a combination of classroom and online training (hereinafter referred to as SKILLSERV -BLENDED).

3. Responsibilities of the Parties:

- i. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be responsible for mobilizing students for the SKILLSERV Program/s by spreading awareness about SKILLSERV Program/s and its potential benefits for the prospective students. FINSERV shall, if requested by PARTNER INSTITUTE, at its discretion, support the awareness campaigns by participating in the student meetings, parent meetings and design of publicity material such as posters, leaflets etc.
- ii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be responsible for providing necessary infrastructure facilities for conducting classroom sessions of SKILLSERV -CLASSROOM and SKILLSERV -BLENDED, specifically (a) one class room, equipped with a projector, a sound system and a white-board with a seating capacity of at least 45 students, (b) one computer room, equipped with computers having MS Office software and high-speed internet connection, with a seating capacity of at least 25 students, for conducting the online assessment tests (c) one assembly hall with a capacity of around 60 persons and 3 interview rooms, for one day per batch, for conducting

SKILLSERV HR Workshop if required. PARTNER INSTITUTE shall also provide basic stationery required for training purposes such as marker pens, chart sheets, chalks etc.

- iii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall appoint a Coordinator for every SKILLSERV batch, with following responsibilities;
 - i. To motivate and encourage students to extract maximum benefit from SKILLSERV Program/s.
 - ii. To provide necessary support to the SKILLSERV Official Training Partner for planning and conducting the program.
 - iii. To conduct online pre-assessment and post-assessment tests for every batch when required in the Program.
 - iv. To ensure that the classes are conducted as per pre-defined schedule.
 - v. To ensure that all students are regularly attending the classes.
 - vi. To maintain daily attendance of the students.
 - vii. To attend few classes as an observer and provide feedback to FINSERV about the training quality.
 - viii. To ensure discipline and good conduct from the students.
 - ix. To support FINSERV team to conduct SKILLSERV HR Workshop for every batch when required for the Program.
 - x. To submit required college information as per Annexure 2 to FINSERV.
- iv. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall issue an appointment letter to the College Coordinator as per format prescribed in Annexure 3 of this MOU. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall submit the appointment letter, duly authorized by the Principal of the PARTNER INSTITUTE and accepted by the College Coordinator, to FINSERV before commencement of every SKILLSERV Batch.
- v. FINSERV shall be responsible to design and continuously improve the SKILLSERV programme structure, including adding or deleting courses, changing pedagogy or modifications to the programme duration.
- vi. FINSERV shall be responsible to arrange faculty, with requisite expertise and experience, through any of its SKILLSERV Official Training Partners. FINSERV shall provide necessary details of the concerned SKILLSERV Official Training Partner to the PARTNER INSTITUTE at least 2 weeks before start of every batch. FINSERV shall be responsible to arrange the online training platform for conducting SKILLSERV - ONLINE and SKILLSERV - BLENDED.
- vii. FINSERV and the PARTNER INSTITUTE, shall be responsible for award of "Certificate of Completion" at the completion of SKILLSERV Program/s to all successful candidates who meet eligibility criteria viz. requisite attendance and credits in the examinations conducted during SKILLSERV Program/s.
- viii. FINSERV, as part of its CSR, shall bear the full cost of faculty deployed by its SKILLSERV Official Training Partner, to ensure that SKILLSERV Program/s is affordable to students belonging to economically weaker sections of the society.
- ix. FINSERV along with its chosen academic partner/s, shall conduct an online examination at the end of SKILLSERV Program/s. Only students who pass this examination and have requisite attendance shall be eligible to receive the "Certificate of Completion". This examination shall be in addition to all other examinations conducted by the SKILLSERV Official Training Partner during SKILLSERV Program/s.
- x. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall display the FINSERV name and logo prominently in all marketing and publicity material, notices for students and all other internal and

external communications, in paper form or otherwise, relating to SKILLSERV Program/s.

- xi. Any other use of FINSERV brand names by the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall require prior written consent from FINSERV.
- xii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall provide to FINSERV, necessary information about all the students of SKILLSERV Program/s, in the format specified by FINSERV in Annexure 1. FINSERV shall be free to contact the students directly for the purpose of monitoring the impact of SKILLSERV Program/s and the career progression of students.
- xiii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall not conduct any of the SKILLSERV Program/s or a programme with identical course structure except in partnership with FINSERV.
- xiv. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be solely responsible to comply with regulations of University Grants Commission or any other authority regulating educational activities in India. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees that FINSERV shall not have any liability including monetary or otherwise, in the event of any regulatory action taken against the PARTNER INSTITUTE in respect of conducting this programme. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees to fully compensate FINSERV in case an action is taken against FINSERV by any such regulatory authority in respect of conduct of SKILLSERV Program/s by the PARTNER INSTITUTE under this MOU.
- xv. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be solely responsible for payment of GST or any other taxes that may be applicable, in respect of fees collected by the PARTNER INSTITUTE for SKILLSERV Program/s and FINSERV shall not have any liability towards the same. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees that FINSERV shall not have any liability, monetary or otherwise, in the event of any action is taken against the PARTNER INSTITUTE by any tax authorities. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees to fully compensate FINSERV in case any action is taken against FINSERV by any such tax authority in respect of conduct of SKILLSERV Program/s by the PARTNER INSTITUTE under this MOU.

4. Batch Strength:

The parties agree that, each batch shall consist of minimum 45 and maximum 60 students. FINSERV and the PARTNER INSTITUTE may mutually decide to start a batch with less than 45 students.

5. Term of the MOU:

The term of this MOU is for a period commencing from signing of this MoU till end of March 31, 2027, except Clause 3(xiii) and Clause 14, which shall continue to be in force for a further period of 3 years from the date of termination of this MOU. The parties may decide to further extend the term of this MOU by mutual consent on such terms and conditions as may be agreed between them.

6. Course fees:

- i. PARTNER INSTITUTE shall charge a non-refundable fee of Rs. 1000 (Rupees One Thousand only) plus applicable GST and other taxes, to each of the students of SKILLSERV towards the course fees. The fee payable by each student shall not be less than Rs. 1,000 (Rupees one thousand only) plus applicable taxes and shall not exceed Rs. 3,000 (Rupees three thousand) plus applicable taxes. The fees specified here shall be valid for two years from signing of this MOU. The fees shall be reviewed on completion of this period and parties may mutually agree to revise the same from time to time.

- ii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE has agreed to suitably remunerate the coordinator and other staff members for their effort towards successful conduct of SKILLSERV Program/s Batch.
- iii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE, may at its own discretion, waive the fees of upto 15% of the students from economically weaker sections, the number of such students must not exceed 15% of total enrolment in the respective batch.
- iv. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall ensure that no student shall be allowed to attend SKILLSERV Program/s without paying the full fees except those permitted under sub-clause iv above.
- v. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall submit to FINSERV, before commencement of any batch, extracts of bank statement or copies of cash receipts or a letter from the Principal or Vice-Principal confirming collection of fees from every participant.

7. Duration and contents of SKILLSERV:

- i. Partner Institute shall commence the SKILLSERV Program/s within 90 days of signing of this MoU. The said Programme will involve training as per the Program/s details as provided under respective Program Annexures, which shall deem to be attached hereto to form part of this MOU.
- ii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE has agreed to mobilize, on best effort basis, at least 40 students in first academic year and at least 80 students from second academic year onwards. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall decide the batch schedule and timings and inform the schedule to FINSERV at least 10 days before commencement of the batch.
- iii. FINSERV shall arrange to make the faculty available as per the schedule informed by the PARTNER INSTITUTE.
- iv. Detailed schedule of the lectures and practical shall be given in advance to students before commencement of SKILLSERV Program/s.

8. Place of teaching:

The SKILLSERV classroom teaching and practical shall be conducted at G I Bagewadi Arts Science and commerce college, Nipani (CMC) by the SKILLSERV Official Training Partner, for up to four hours a day on such days, dates and at such timings as may be mutually decided between the parties.

9. Eligibility for SKILLSERV:

- i. Any student who is a student/alumni of the College and fits in the eligibility criteria (academic + Age Limit) for the Program shall be eligible to apply for admission to SKILLSERV Program/s.
- ii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall select the final list of candidates for admission based on the criteria mutually agreed upon by the PARTNER INSTITUTE and FINSERV from time to time.

10. Discipline and right to expel:

- i. The students of SKILLSERV -CLASSROOM and SKILLSERV -BLENDED shall be subject to rules of discipline/code of conduct of the PARTNER INSTITUTE during course

period. In case of SKILLSERV – ONLINE, the students shall be subject to rules of discipline/code of conduct of the SKILLSERV Official Training Partner.

- ii. If the concerned SKILLSERV Official Training Partner observes a breach of code of conduct by any student, it shall immediately report the same to the College SKILLSERV Coordinator for necessary action.
- iii. If any participant commits breach of code of conduct of the PARTNER INSTITUTE, the faculty shall have full authority to expel such student for the remaining duration of SKILLSERV Program/s.

11. Faculty:

- i. FINSERV shall be solely responsible for arranging, through a SKILLSERV Official Training Partner, faculty, with requisite industry and teaching experience, and conducting SKILLSERV efficiently and effectively. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall not be responsible for making any payments to the faculty of the SKILLSERV Official Training Partner.
- ii. Some of the lectures of SKILLSERV may be conducted by the experts from FINSERV as per the understanding between the parties. However, the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall not be liable to pay any amounts to FINSERV towards the said lectures.

12. Certification:

FINSERV and the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall issue a "Certificate of Completion" in SKILLSERV Program/s to the eligible students of SKILLSERV-CLASSROOM, SKILLSERV -ONLINE and SKILLSERV -BLENDED. The certificates shall be designed and printed by FINSERV and shall carry the names of the PARTNER INSTITUTE and the concerned SKILLSERV Official Training Partner.

13. Further Agreements:

The parties agree that, they may mutually discuss and enter into further agreements, if needed.

14. Confidentiality:

- i. The Parties agree to maintain strict secrecy and confidentiality regarding any and all Confidential Information exchanged or to be exchanged between them in relation to this MOU.
- ii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees that all the course material provided by FINSERV or the SKILLSERV Official Training Partner, including but not limited to SKILLSERV structure, curriculum, lesson plans and evaluation methods, shall be deemed to be Confidential Information.
- iii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees that any of FINSERV's technical or business or other information including information given for development of any case studies / development of any program modules / contents, made available by FINSERV or its personnel to the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be deemed to be Confidential Information.
- iv. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees to restrict access and disclosure of Confidential Information to such of their employees, agents, vendors, and contractors strictly on a "need to know" basis, to maintain confidentiality of the Information disclosed to it in accordance with this clause.

- v. Information and material disclosed and provided by each party to the other party in pursuance of or in connection with performance of its obligation under this MOU shall, at all times, remain the sole and exclusive property of the disclosing Party.

15. Intimation about cancellation/postponement of SKILLSERV Program/s:

- i. If due to any cogent reasons, it appears to the PARTNER INSTITUTE that it is unable to arrange any batch as per schedule, the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall intimate about its inability to FINSERV at least 30 days in advance and the parties shall decide further schedule of SKILLSERV Program/s by mutual consent. FINSERV may decide to complete such batches through online classes.
- ii. However, if such postponement or cancellation is necessitated due to any last minute, unforeseen and unavoidable circumstances like Act of God, civil commotion, strike, bandh, disruption of traffic, epidemic, war, aggression, change in Government Policy or any other similar circumstances, the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall intimate the change in schedule as early as possible after such circumstances as stated above have arisen. In such circumstances, the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall not be held liable for payment towards any loss or damages caused to FINSERV due to delay in its schedule.
- iii. If for any reason, FINSERV, decides to discontinue support for SKILLSERV Program/s, it shall give a written notice to the PARTNER INSTITUTE, 30 days in advance. Such notice shall not impact any batch which is already in progress on the date of notice and the terms of this MOU shall continue to apply to the running batches.

16. Amendment/Termination:

- i. Any amendment to the terms of this MOU can only be made by mutual consent of the parties.
- ii. This MOU may be terminated by either party, for breach of terms and conditions of the present MOU or otherwise, by a written notice of at least one (1) month in advance. Such notice of termination shall not interfere with the batches underway at the relevant time. Such batches shall be allowed to continue until their conclusion.
- iii. Both the parties agree that Finserv shall have the right of terminating this MOU without any notice to the PARTNER INSTITUTE, if the PARTNER INSTITUTE charges a fee exceeding the amount prescribed under Clause 6(i) of this MOU. In such event, the batches underway at the relevant time, may also be terminated by FINSERV, unless the PARTNER INSTITUTE refunds the excess fee charged to every student of the batch.

17. Applicable Law and Dispute Settlement:

- i. This MOU shall be governed by the Laws of India.
- ii. Any dispute arising between the parties in connection with or arising out of the performance of mutual obligations under this MOU shall be resolved by mutual discussion and consultation. If the dispute remained unresolved even after 30 days, then the dispute shall be referred to the Principal/Director/Vice Chancellor/Dean of G I Bagewadi Arts Science and commerce college and Mr. Kurush Irani, President – Corporate Social Responsibility, Bajaj Finserv Limited. The decision of the principal of G I Bagewadi Arts Science and commerce college and Mr. Kurush Irani shall be final and binding on both parties.

18. Originals:

This MOU is executed by electronic means by way of affixing DSC of the Authorised person (i.e. Mr. Kurush Irani) of Finserv on the one hand and through Aadhar based OTP authentication e-signing of Authorised representative of Partner Institute on the other hand. Both parties agree that, electronically executed copy of this MOU shall be considered as Digital Record under Section 65B of Indian Evidence Act, 1872.

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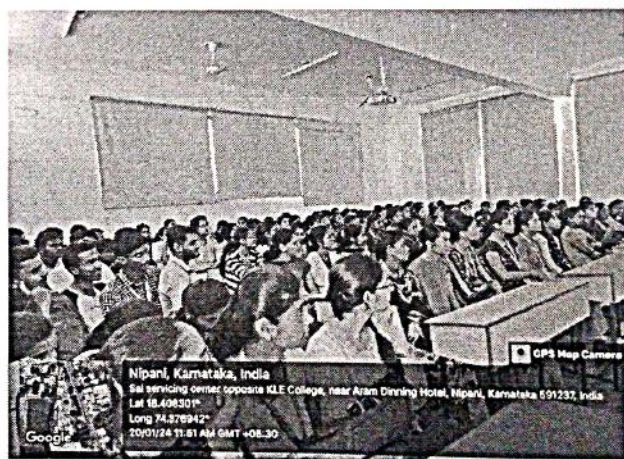



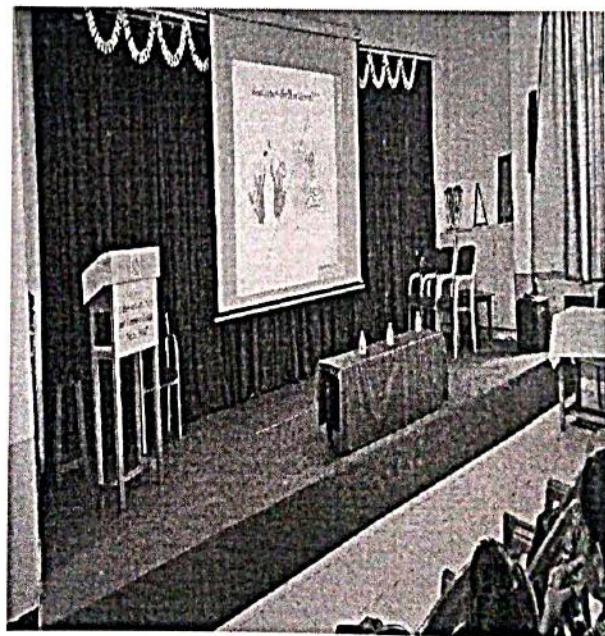
