


#### **Outcome of the Orientation Programme "Malhar"**

#### GENERALRULES

- 1. Every students of this College should posses the Identity Card with his/her photo fixed on it duly attested by the Principal.
- 2. Students should have their Identity Card when they go to the Library, Laboratories Examination hall, Gymkhana and College office. The Identity Card must be produced whenever demanded by any member of the college staff.

#### CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE STUDENTS OF THE COLLEGE

The following guidelines are issued in order to help the students to conduct themselves courteously and in accordance with the highest standards of mannerly behavior


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

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
